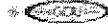

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

At the next regular scheduled membership meeting on August 6, 2009, the new office building located at 285 W. 6th Street, San Pedro will be discussed. The Executive Board passed the motion on June 25, 2009 *M/S/C To allow Local 13 Officers to sign a purchase agreement and enter into escrow for the office building located at 285 W. 6th Street once a purchase price has been negotiated.* These minutes were approved at the July 9, 2009 regular membership meeting.

Local 13 is currently opening escrow. This issue will be addressed and you will be kept abreast of the progress.

HARRY BRIDGES BIRTHDAY PAID HOLIDAY

Harry Bridges Birthday, Tuesday, July 28, 2009 is a paid holiday. Only registered persons who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2008) and meet the availability requirements for at least two of the five days, exclusive of the holiday Monday through Friday. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two days Monday, July 27th; Wednesday, July 29th; Thursday, July 30th and Friday, July 31, 2009.

Under the current contract one does not have to meet the availability requirement if you worked 1300 hours in the prior payroll year (2008) to receive the Harry Bridges holiday pay.

Persons taking a vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk in the Dispatch Hall on or before Friday, July 31, 2009 or you will not receive the holiday pay. Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk on or before Friday, September 18, 2009.

The Harry Bridges holiday will be paid on August 14, 2009.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS/PHONE

It is **YOUR** responsibility to update your phone number/address with the Health Benefits Department at Local 13 and the PMA. Failure to do so may result in your not receiving important documents such as LRC site letters, beneficiary documentation, etc.
