UTR'S AT EAGLE MARINE SERVICES

Eagle Marine Services (APL) has notified Local 13, effective Thursday, January 28, 2010; ALL UTR'S FOR MARINE OPERATIONS (against the vessel) will be assigned by the Foreman after your safety speech. Below are the signs that will be posted in the parking areas.



ATTENTION ALL EQUIPMENT OPERATORS

Operators of Powered Industrial Truck (PIT) equipment must be evaluated every three years in each piece of PIT equipment:

- Forklift/Heavy Lift
- Top/Side Pick
- UTR
- Bulldozer
- Locomotive

“Operators, who have been previously certified on each piece of equipment, will be re-valuated for the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. During this period, operators, who have had **eight (8) hours** or more of safe operation (no unresolved complaints on that piece of equipment), will be recertified on that equipment.” (CLRC minutes 09-A-04, dates changed)

In order to be re-certified you must have driven each piece of equipment a minimum of eight (8) hours since July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. (Please note you must have been paid a minimum of eight (8) hours, so if you only worked one hoot shift you will need to pick-up one more job). If you have not taken a job on a particular piece of equipment yet, please do so before the June 30, 2010 cut-off date. If you fail to take the job you will be required to take a one-day unpaid refresher course in order to get recertified.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS/PHONE

It is ***YOUR*** responsibility to update your phone numbers (home and cell) along with your address with the Health Benefits Department at Local 13 and the PMA. Failure to do so may result in your not receiving important documents such as LRC site letters, beneficiary documentation, etc.

CRITERIA FOR PORT HUENEME NAVAL BASE PASS

(Please read this entire document from beginning to end)

Attention all Brothers & Sisters that are interested in traveling to Port Hueneeme. The Department of Defense requires that individuals, who wish to work as longshoreman on vessels docked on the Naval Base, **MUST** have a pass to access the Naval Base in Port Hueneeme. The majority of Port Hueneeme is **NOT** on the military base, however one (1) Berth is. If you are interested in working at this berth in Port Hueneeme, you **MUST HAVE ALL** of the following (**THIS IS NOT NEGOTIABLE**):

- Naval Base Pass
- Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC)
- Valid California Driver's License
- Valid vehicle registration (Out of state plates must provide smog certificate)
- Proof of auto insurance

In addition to the above documents, you will be subjected to random background checks, as well as agreeing to random searches while on the Naval Base.

The following items listed below will disqualify you from eligibility for a naval base pass as per Department of Defense regulation document #NBVCINST 5530.2

1. *A felony criminal conviction involving the use of a firearm, aggravated assault, robbery, rape, controlled substance sales or distribution or any criminal act resulting in death.*
2. *A felony criminal conviction for drunken driving, grand larceny, or possession of a controlled substance within the past ten (10) years.*
3. *Misdemeanor criminal convictions for any larceny, drunk driving, or assault within the past five (5) years.*
4. *Any current or active arrest warrant.*

The information obtained in the background inquiry is privileged and protected by the Privacy Act of 1974.

The specific results of the background inquiry will not be disclosed; only a positive or negative decision to issue the NBVC Badge will be provided to the Pass and Identification Office. The disqualifying criteria will be objectively applied to the results of the background inquiry to make a final determination.

Sign-ups for the Naval Base pass will be limited to 1,000 Class A and/or B members per Department of Defense mandate. If more than 1,000 sign up, seniority will prevail. **SIGN UPS DO NOT GUARANTEE A NAVAL BASE PASS. Please do not sign up on the list if you are not intending to work in Port Hueneeme.**

Sign-ups will begin on **Tuesday, January 5, 2010** in the Records Clerks Office during normal business hours and will close on **Friday, January 29, 2010 @ 3:30 p.m.**

Once you are signed up on the list the only access to the Naval Base will be through the Pleasant Valley Gate. If you have any questions, the LRC Representatives will be available at the Records Clerk Office on Tuesday mornings from 6:30 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. **DO NOT CALL Port Hueneeme!**
