NOMINATIONS OPEN FOR 2010 SPRING ELECTION

Nominations for the 2010 Spring Election will open at the Regular Membership Meeting on Thursday, February 4, 2010 for the following offices and committees:

President (1), Vice-President (1), LRC Representative (1), Day Business Agent (1), Night Business Agent (1), Trustee (2), Day Dispatchers (5), Day Flex Dispatcher (1), Chairman of Stewards (1), Casual Hall Dispatcher (1), Casual Hall Sgt.-At-Arms (1), Publicity Committee (3), Promotions Committee (3), Grievance Committee (10), Membership Committee (16) and Executive Board (25).

The deadline for the submission of nominees is Saturday, March 6, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. Nomination papers must be turned in at ILWU Local 13, 320 Golden Shore Drive, Suite 300, Long Beach, CA 90802.

Elections will be held on Tuesday, March 9th, Wednesday, March 10th and Thursday, March 11th. Run-off elections will be held on Tuesday, March 23rd Wednesday, March 24th and Thursday, March 25th. Voting will take place at the ILWU Memorial Hall, 231 W. "C" Street, Wilmington, 90744. The polls will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on each day.

ELIGIBILITY TO RUN FOR OFFICE

In accordance with the Constitution and By-Laws, Article IV, Section 1, Sub-Section (f) and Article XI, Section 1, Sub-Section (b). For a member to be considered in good standing, they shall have their dues, fines, and assessments paid in full every month for twelve consecutive months prior to picking up a nomination form. No nomination form shall be issued to the member if this criteria has not been met.

Article IV, Section 1, Sub-Section f

"In order to have his name placed on the ballot and to hold any office or position, each candidate must have been in good standing and an active Longshoreman in the industry in this Local or working in the ILWU for the previous twelve (12) months."

Article XI, Section 1, Sub-Section b

"Dues are due and payable on the first day of each month. A member is in good standing only when his dues, assessments or other indebtedness are paid on or before the delinquent dates, as determined by the Local."

Eagle Marine Services (APL) has notified Local 13, effective **Sunday, January 31, 2010**; ALL UTR'S FOR MARINE OPERATIONS (against the vessel) will be assigned by the Foreman after your safety speech.

STEPS TO TAKE IF INJURED ON THE JOB

Section 6, Rule 602 of the Pacific Coast Marine Safety Code

An injury of any kind, irrespective of its severity, shall be reported immediately to the foreman, walking boss, or man in charge of operations, by the injured person, if he/she is physically able to do so. If not, the injury shall be reported by any other person in possession of the facts.

Step 1: Report injury to walking boss, foreman. Complete LS-201 form from the employer. Obtain any information; i.e. if there are any witnesses, make sure to obtain their names, registration #, and if possible their phone numbers where they can be reached.

Step 2: **LS-1 Request for Examination and/or Treatment:**

This form must be given by the employer to the injured worker upon notification of injury. It must be presented to the doctor at the time of examination. The injured worker has the right to be examined by any physician or medical facility of their choice.
